

The Black Wall Street Inspiration Hour of Power
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Episode #1003—The Fruit of Love –Victorious /Triumphant Love

Recap—I began this series discussing the Fruit of the Spirit and I am going to continue to teach about the Fruit of the Spirit and last week we began discussing about the 1st of the 9 Fruit of the Spirit—Love (which is an inward condition) and also reviewed how Christians have an identity problem; meaning are we displaying the fruit of being Christ like? Are we living the life?

Opening—Love is “unconditional” and if we choose to love and how we display it is a “heart condition”.

The definition of “unconditional” is—not subject to any conditions.

1. God’s love is NOT self-seeking... (how many times we have failed God, yet he still loves us)
2. Unfortunately, many people who say that they love us are tolerating us to benefit from us...
3. My grandmother used to say, “The love has cooled off” ...
4. God created you, to love on you—and everything that God allows in your life is because of the love he has for you
 - A. The “Correction” (this does not mean he loves you less)
 - B. The “Blessing” (when he blesses you it doesn’t mean that he loves your move)

A. **Triumphant Love**

Romans 8:38-39--New Living Translation

38 And I am convinced that nothing can ever separate us from God’s love. Neither death nor life, neither angels nor demons,[a] neither our fears for

today nor our worries about tomorrow—not even the powers of hell can separate us from God’s love. 39 No power in the sky above or in the earth below—indeed, nothing in all creation will ever be able to separate us from the love of God that is revealed in Christ Jesus our Lord.

1. The Apostle Paul declares this reassurance for every Christian believer...

A. In the book of Romans, Apostle Paul’s words echoes what was written in the Psalm (1,000 to 1,100 years)--

“I can never escape from your Spirit! I can never get away from your presence! If I go up to heaven, you are there; if I go down to the grave, you are there!” (Psalm 139:7–8, NLT). –King David (realized that God know us completed, in and out)—my opinion he wrote this after he had messed up in life...

B. God is present everywhere. There is no place we can go and be separated from His presence.

C. The Bible also tells us that God’s nature is love. And if [God is love](#) and exists everywhere, there is no place you can go to be isolated / secluded from His love.

1 John 4:8 (NKJV)—“He who does not love does not know God, for God is love”

1 John 4:16 (NKJV)—And we have known and believed the love that God has for us. God is love, and he who abides in love abides in God, and God in him

D. The Apostle Paul declares that nothing exists that is persuasive enough to create a barrier between you and the **immeasurable** love of God in Christ. On the cross at Calvary, Jesus claimed the victory over death and everything you will ever go through.

E. Those that are in Christ have been raised to newness in life and nothing we go through can cause lasting harm because Jesus paid the price for our penalties...

F. You can walk away from Him... (not God’s will for your life)

G. When we feel separated from God it is not him pulling away, it is our perception from our perspective...

H. Be careful of your emotions... (*We must stand on 1 Corinthians 13:8, "Love NEVER fails"*) –It's just a storm, this too shall pass.

B. Love is Daring

1. God's love is not apprehensive or afraid, it is lionhearted / fearless, proactive (taking care of something before it becomes a situation)—he is not reactive; God sees a thing from the "end", where we can only see from the beginning...
2. We have to dare to take God at his Word (requires faith) ...
3. We have to believe that even while we are going through "THIS" trial God is still with us and Jesus is advocating for us. (He has not left us.)
4. God's love dares you to change / become transformed—You take one step towards change and God will help you with the changes you need to make.
5. It takes guts to live a righteous life; to become completely souled out for Christ... (there is a lot of things that you will have to walk away from)
6. It takes tenacity to do what God calls you to, and watch the Devil do everything he can to pervert it or destroy it—your witness / your reputation...

C. What are the expectations? Love requires action!

1. 1 Corinthians 13:4-8 (Read reference page—How it is expressed and what love will do?)
